- JURISDICTION**; Held under the National Sporting Code of the ACU. ACU Standing Regulations for Track Racing these Supplementary Regulations and any instructions that may be issued later.
- ELIGIBILITY**; All drivers and passengers must hold a current ACU Competition Licence or International Licence issued by the ACU,SACU,or theMCU of Ireland. If a one-day licence is required, proof of identity MUST BE PRODUCED (DRIVING LICENCE/ PASSPORT)
- ENTRIES**; To be sent to the Secretary on official entry form with the correct fee;Adult solo £25, Sidecar £30 YOUTH £18 **MAKE CHEQUES TO WAINFLEET & DIST S.M. C.C ENTRIES CLOSE MONDAY 8th May PLEASE INCLUDE S.A.E.**
- SCRUTINEERING**; of machines, clothing ,Helmets, Back protectors, Must be completed before official practice begins. ALL Competitors must have a fire extinguisher, Environmental Mat, TYRES;- NO 2 ply Speedway tyres to be used on SIDECAR DRIVE WHEEL others as ACU. SCRUTINEERING 10-00am.
- PRACTICE**; will commence at 12- noon Finnish 1.00pm propt. NO ENGINES TO BE STARTED BEFORE 11-45am
- START**; OFF TRACK Clutch start controlled by elastic gate First Race 1-30pm
- FLAG SIGNALS**; As Standing Regulations.ANY DRIVER IGNORING FLAG SIGNALS WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM THE MEETING. IT IS VITAL THAT MARSHALLS, FIRST-AID CREWS AND FALLEN RIDERS RECEIVE THEIR PROTECTION.
- COURSE**; Length approximately 450mt Riders seen riding beyond the track markers inside or out Will BE EXCLUDED FROM THAT RACE.

2006 YOUTH REGULATIONS

- These supplementary regulations are to be read in conjunction with the main regulations for the meeting.
- Youth Grasstrack machines will be grouped together and run under in accordance with 2006 standing regulations for youth grasstrack.
- The club reserve the right to run classes together where insufficient entries are received.
- Grasstrack and Motocross machines will not compete in the same race EXCEPT CADETS & AUTO CADETS (WHERE PERMITTED)
- CLASSES**
Grasstrack ; Cadet & Auto Cadet / Junior / Intermediate / Senior /
- Age groups and class capacity details as in the 2006 A.C.U Handbook.
- All youth competitors MUST include a completed parental agreement form.
- All machines (including motocross) must have a lanyard – style cut out fitted and working.

(ADULT) A MINIMUM OF 6 ENTRIES IS REQUIRED IN ALL CLASSES.
